Dog Centerpiece

Things to gather:

Construction paper
Dog faces and fire-hydrant patterns
Markers
Dowels
Glue and tape
Small bucket
Styrofoam
Dog bones

Print and cut out the desired number of dog faces and fire hydrants. Cut the number of dowels to match the number of faces and hydrants. Tape each face and hydrant to a dowel. Glue or tape a dog bone under each dog's chin. Fill the bucket with a piece of Styrofoam. Insert the dowels in the foam at different heights. To finish, cover the top of the foam with dog bones.
